













scleronychia?

condition of hardening of the nails




keratosis?

- (lesions on outer layer of skin caused from too much sun exposure)


necrosis –necrosis necr/o + -osis

seborrhea?


- Over production of skin oil that causes white to yellowish scales.






Prefixes

 - pertaining to through the skin (absorbed)






- autograft or dermatoautoplasty?
