Male Reproduction Anatomy

- · balan/o
 - penis
- epididym/o
 - epididymis duct atop testes that stores sperm and carries it to the vas deferens
- orchid/o, orchi/o, orch/o, test/o
 - testicle, testis
 - produce testosterone and sperm cells

andr/o, M = Male



Male Reproduction Anatomy

- sperm/o, spermat/o
 - sperm
- prostat/o
 - prostate gland
 - upper end of urethra; secretes fluid that aids in the movement of sperm
- · vas/o
 - vas deferens
 - duct that carries sperm from epididymis to the urethra



Male Reproductive Diseases & Disorders

BPH

- Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia
- noncancerous, excessive development of the prostate gland

cryptorchidism

- crypt/o = hidden
- orchid/o = testes
- -ism = condition
- undescended testicles; state of hidden testes

Male Reproductive Diseases & Disorders

prostate cancer

- cancer of the prostate gland
- most commonly diagnosed cancer in men
- usually occurs later in life

PSA

- prostate-specific antigen
- blood test that measures for prostate cancer

Reproductive Diseases & Disorders

HIV

- human immunodeficiency virus
- a type of virus that causes AIDS

AIDS

- acquired immunodeficiency syndrome
- a disease that affects the body's immune system
- transmitted sexually, by contaminated needles, or contaminated blood transfusions

Reproductive Diseases & Disorders


STD/STI

sexually transmitted disease/infection

HPV

- human papillomavirus (pap-i-LO-ma-virus)
- STD that causes genital warts

Male Reproductive System

coitus, copulation

sexual intercourse

circumcision

surgical removal of the foreskin

DRE

- digital rectal exam
- PE in which the physician inserts a finger into the rectum and feels for size and shape of prostate gland through the rectal wall

Male Reproductive System

vasectomy

- surgical removal of a portion of the vas deferens
- results in male sterilization

sterilization

process that makes one unable to reproduce

infertility

reduced or absent ability to produce offspring
